



ROAD CAPTAIN REQUIREMENTS 2009

The following is a list of requirements and expectations for all Road Captains in The Lighthouse HOG Chapter. The list is not all inclusive and satisfying all of the requirements does not automatically make a member eligible to be a Road Captain.

All current Road Captains will participate in the selection and vetting process of prospective Road Captains but the final determination will be made by the Head and Assistant Head Road Captain.

Minimum Requirements:

- I. A member in good standing of Lighthouse HOG for a minimum of one year¹.
- II. The member must hold a current motorcycle license.
- III. The members' motorcycle must have a current inspection, where required.
- IV. The member must have demonstrated participation in Chapter Rides with enough frequency that all current Road Captains recognize the member and can to some degree comment on the prospects riding capabilities and skills. As a general rule of thumb the member should have participated in at least 50% of Chapter rides during the last 12 months.
- V. All new Road Captains will be in a probationary status for a period of up to 3 months during which time they will be required to actively participate in chapter activities and rides and attend all Road Captain meetings.

¹ Past Chapter members who were active club participants previously but became inactive may immediately be eligible upon rejoining the Chapter if they meet all other minimum requirements.



ROAD CAPTAIN REQUIREMENTS 2009

Once a member has met the requirements to be a Road Captain and is selected there are ongoing responsibilities and expectations that must be met to stay active as a Road Captain in the Chapter, the list that follows is a guide:

Ongoing Road Captain Responsibilities and Expectations:

- I. Participate, on average, in at least 50% of all the club rides and events.
- II. Attend at least 8 of the 11 Road Captain Meetings held during the year.
- III. Lead at least 3 Chapter rides a year; 2 of which should be during peak riding season; April - October.
- IV. Participate in both Dealership and Club sponsored events by helping to cook, serve, organize, set up, and generally provide support when required. This includes Dealer Open Houses, Chapter Bike Nights, Chapter Meetings and other special events as needed.
- V. Have and keep current in both basic First Aid Training and Advanced Rider Course - refresh at least once every 3 years.
- VI. Before and during club rides refrain from alcohol; zero tolerance for recreational drug use.
- VII. Wear Chapter Colors when participating in Chapter events and Armbands when on club rides.
- VIII. Actively welcome new members and riders to the Chapter.
